### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ASC is contracted to the Commonwealth of Australia under the Collins Class Submarine In Service Support Contract (ISSC) to undertake the sustainment and enhancement of the Collins Class Submarines (CCSM). The ISSC is a long-term, performance-based contract that is intended to remain in place until the end of service of the CCSMs, including the Life of Type Extension (LOTE) program, out to the mid-2040's.

ASC performs the critical role of CCSM supply chain manager under the ISSC. As part of this role, ASC establishes and manages subcontracts with a wide range of Australian companies that provide services and supplies to support the sustainment and upgrade of the CCSM. A sample of these Australian companies is shown in the table below.

The primary locations for the delivery of these services and supplies are ASC's sites at Osborne in South Australia and Henderson in Western Australia.

## SCOPE OF WORK OPPORTUNITIES

Our priority on incorporating Australian content has seen us grow Australian Industry Content from 70 per cent during the Collins Class build to as high as 92 per cent in sustainment. These strong levels of Australian content enhance the resilience of the sovereign program, maximise local jobs and skills development, and contribute to the national economy.

There are upcoming opportunities for Australian companies to become an ASC subcontractor and support the sustainment and enhancement of the CCSM.

The work packages that are expected to be released to the market during 2021/2022 for competitive tender include but are not limited to:

These work packages will be released by ASC as Requests for Information (RFI) and / or Requests for Proposal (RFP) directly to companies that have pre-registered with ASC and indirectly through the Industry Capability Network ([www.icn.org.au](http://www.icn.org.au)). Subcontracts will be awarded based on evaluation criteria that include value for money, quality, delivery standards, flexibility and responsiveness to support ASC and the CCSM Program.

ASC may release further work packages during the course of the Financial Year 2021/2022.

As with existing subcontracts, the primary locations for the delivery of these services and supplies are ASC's sites at Osborne and Henderson.
